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VDOT J43 Bridge over I-95 - Prince William, VA

Saw-cut Demolition and Placement of Vertical & Overhead Shotcrete

DESCRIPTION:

CSI was selected to restore the J43 Bridge over Interstate 95 in Prince William, Virginia. The state-funded project, owned by the Virginia Department of Transportation, required an aggressive schedule to complete all work prior to the onset of cold weather.

SCOPE OF WORK:

The CSI team performed saw-cut demolition of compromised concrete bridge supports in preparation for vertical and overhead placement of shotcrete. Prior to full-scale shotcrete placement, CSI shotcrete technicians completed successful mockup panels, and concrete coring tests verified the proper consolidation of concrete behind the intersection of the vertical and horizontal reinforcing steel.

The project was successfully completed on time and to the full satisfaction of VDOT officials.
